Wimple 1 & 2: Wimple making is our First Grade Family Program. Family come together twice, to create a wimple together. A wimple is a piece of cloth decorated by kids and adults together with the child's Hebrew name and a prayer. The wimple is used at the B'nei Mitzvah to wrap the Torah in.
