Article XII, Section 10

Section 10: Tikkun Olam Committee - The Tikkun Olam Social Action Committee (formerly Social Action Committee) works to create and promote opportunities for all of the Congregation Beth Israel community to participate in repair of the world. The Committee will also have the responsibility of making recommendations to the Board of Trustees for allocations from the Social Action Tribute Funds. The recommendations will be guided by the Tikkun Olam Committee's vetting of the recipient parties and will include the suggested distribution amount. - shall study and analyze local, state, national and international issues and concerns in relationship to the principles of Judaism. The Social Action Committee shall sensitize the congregation to the moral and ethical implications of these issues and concerns. It shall speak or encourage action only with prior approval of the Board of Trustees the parties to be recipients of the Social Action Fund and the approximate distribution amount or fund distribution percentage to be distributed to each recipient.
